

Parking?

Capacity in lots is affected by shared use and construction. Allowing ample arrival time is suggested. There are few special events during the summer; however, if special event personnel are posted at lot entrances (e.g. June 15-17, 2017, July 25- 26, 2017) event parking restrictions supercede general parking. A parking fee (cash only) may be required at the lot entrance. General Sports Camps 2017 camper and visitor parking information is below. Corresponding lot numbers and locations may be found at maps.msu.edu under the Main Map.

Registration, Check-in/check-out, move-in/move-out, visiting camps, attending camps:

Complimentary CAMPER & SPORTS CAMP VISITOR parking (daily & overnight):

Lot 83 (off Service Road, near Harrison Road) Dates: June 11, 2017 - July 30, 2017

Complimentary SPORTS CAMP VISITOR parking (daily only, no overnight):

Ramp 7 (parking structure off Harrison Road near Shaw Lane intersection) Dates: June 11, 2017 - July 30, 2017

Complimentary SATURDAY & SUNDAY only; otherwise pay-to-park applies (see below):

Lots 62W (IM West), 67 (Jenison Fieldhouse) & 79 (South end of Spartan Stadium, access off Shaw Lane)

Dates: Saturdays and Sundays between June 11, 2017 - July 30, 2017 **(Lot 79 is slated to be closed entirely starting around 7/1/17 and will not be available for the remainder of Sports Camps 2017 after that date).**

Pay-to-park (daily only, no overnight):

- Visitor pay lots (cash only at exit, Monday - Friday): Lots 62W (north of IM West) & 79 (south of stadium). Parking is restricted 2am-6am every day. Please note that Lot 63W (at Breslin) will not be available to park in due to construction.

- Metered parking : Check hours of operation at meter (e.g. residence hall meters require payment 7am-midnight, every day). Pay-by-plate locations (e.g. Lot 39 near the International Center) requires payment and entry of your plate at its kiosk immediately after parking. Parking is restricted 2am-6am.

- Sports Camps visitor permits: Required in lots signed at their entrances as reserved for those with employee permits. Such lots include Lot 67 (except Saturday & Sunday) near the Jenison Fieldhouse and Lots 71, 72, 73 & 74 near the camp residence halls (most spaces require a permit seven days a week). Lot 63E (at Breslin) will not be available to park in due to construction. The permits are limited to Sports Camps visitor use only (campers use Lot 83). Permits may be purchased from the MSU Parking Office online or at their office. For details, go to <http://scp.police.msu.edu> *Parking enforcement is in effect. Vehicles illegally parked (e.g.in a space requiring a permit, parking on hash marks, in a University vehicle or lease space, outside a space, along a curb, in the grass, obstructing traffic, in a space requiring a valid disability placard or plate) are subject to enforcement. The camp office has no authority over parking for camps and therefore cannot assist you with any parking issues or violations you may receive. Parking is enforced by the Parking Division of the MSU Police Department. They may be contacted at 517-355-8440 should you have parking questions.*
